Evaluation notes: The educational system in Colombia follows the 5+4+2 model, i.e. 5 years of primary education (Educación Básica Primaria), 4 years of lower secondary education (Educación Básica Secundaria), and 2 years of upper secondary education (Educación Media). Upon finishing the sixth year of college preparatory secondary school, students are usually issued the Título de Bachiller (Baccalaureate Title). Specialized high schools may issue a commercial, industrial, or technical Bachiller.

This student attended the SAMPLE SCHOOL in Bogotá, Colombia for his upper secondary education in the commercial track. He completed all the program requirements and was granted the Bachiller on GRADUATION DATE.
